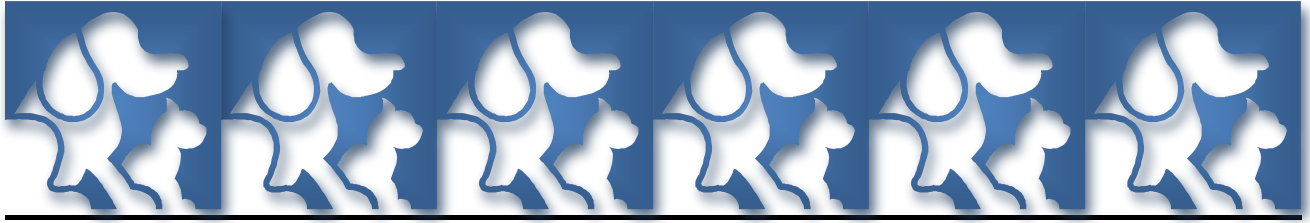

Volunteer Dress Code

Whenever you come as a volunteer to the shelter, including orientation and training classes, you must follow the volunteer dress code. This is for your safety and saves the shelter from liability issues.



You must wear a sleeved shirt. It can be short sleeved or long sleeved, but you must have sleeves. No tank tops, tube tops, or spaghetti strapped tops.



Long pants that completely cover your leg must be worn at all times. No capris, shorts, skirts, or dresses. The only exception is for outings. You are allowed to wear knee length shorts or capris to outing events.



Shoes that completely cover your feet including your toes and have rubber soles must be worn at the shelter. The floors are often wet and slippery! No heels, flats, sandals, or slick soled shoes.

Once you have completed our initial volunteer orientation class a name tag will be waiting for you at the shelter. Once you pick it up that day we ask that you take it with you and wear it at all times when representing the shelter as a volunteer.
